EIS Executive Chairman, Mr Lee Fook Sun, said: “We are pleased that Keat Chuan has agreed to serve as our interim CEO, while he helps us undertake a search for a longer term leader of the firm.

“His experience and vision will help steer Ensign towards achieving our immediate goal of integrating the expertise from our founding partners to provide robust cyber-defence capabilities to our customers in Singapore and the region.”
